#### **JOB DESCRIPTION**

## **General Description**

The purpose of this class within the organization is to supervise and manage Fire personnel in accordance with city and departmental policies, procedures, rules and regulations.

## **Duties and Responsibilities**

The functions listed below are those that represent the majority of the time spent working in this class. Management may assign additional functions related to the type of work of the class as necessary.

- Supervises and evaluates assigned staff; handles employee concerns, directs work assignment, counsels and disciplines employees when necessary.
- Serves as station officer for multi-company fire station; serves as fire ground commander until relieved by superior officer; plans and assigns personnel and equipment at emergency situations.
- Supervises rescue and fire suppression activities on assigned shift; plans and directs daily operations of station.
- Supervises on-duty personnel in performance of job duties including station activities involving equipment maintenance and clean up.
- Develops pre-fire plans including equipment, water availability, fire exits and number of people; updates territorial maps.
- Administers first response emergency medical care; administers first aid and CPR.
- Researches, develops, and ensures delivery of specialized training programs based on needs.
- Maintains training records for all members and produces reports as required.
- Assumes duties of Battalion Chief as required; conducts periodic meetings with staff and Shift Training Officers to assess departmental training needs and develop drills, evolutions, and procedures to meet these needs.
- Assists in fire drills and mock disasters including set-up and evacuation.
- Participates in mandatory physical fitness program.
- Performs related work as assigned.

# **Minimum Education and Experience Requirements:**

Requires an Associate's Degree or specialized courses/training equivalent to satisfactory completion of two years of college in Fire Science, Firefighting or closely related field; Must have six years of progressively responsible experience in the full-time paid fire department or closely related experience; Required qualifications may be any equivalent combination of education, training and experience which provides the requisite knowledge, skills and abilities for this job.
